

Sam Crawford Classic July 1-2, 2023 10U Rules

Entry Fee: \$200

Game Length: 6 innings

Pitching Distance: 46 ft. Bases: 65 ft.

Individual Pitching Limitations:

If you pitch 60 pitches or less, you can pitch the next day You can only pitch a max of 80 pitches in one day You can only pitch a max of 140 pitches for the tournament

Turn in pitch cards to the concession stand immediately after the end of your game.

Pitchers will be given one balk warning per pitcher per inning

Run Rules:

15 after 3 innings 10 after 4 innings

No inning can start after 1 hr. 45 min.

In the event of a tie at the end of regulation play the California Tie Break will be used.

Coaches may choose before game starts to:

- -Bat entire roster (free substitution)
- -Bat nine and use normal substitution with starters being able to re-enter the game once in their original batting order spot.
- -If a team bats the entire roster and there is an injury, the injured player's spot in the batting order will be skipped and no out will be recorded.

Pitcher may not re-enter as a pitcher.

Straight baseball rules will be played with the following exceptions. Base runners are not allowed to lead. Runners on 1st and 2nd may advance after the ball has crossed the plate. **Home plate is closed.** Runner on third may only advance on a batted ball or if a play is made in the field except for returning the ball from catcher back to pitcher. A dropped third strike is an out. There is a run limit per inning of 6 runs. Umpires rulings are final. (No Protests Allowed)

Any coach ejected from a game will also miss the team's next game as well.

Teams will be seeded according to (1) record (2) run differential (max 8/game) (3) fewest runs allowed (4) most runs scored (5) then coin flip.



12U Rules

Entry Fee: \$200

Game Length: 6 innings

Pitching Distance: 50 ft. Bases: 70 ft.

Individual Pitching Limitations:

If you have 60 pitches or less, you can pitch the next day

You can pitch a max of 80 pitches in one day

You can pitch a total of 140 pitches for the whole tournament

Turn in pitch cards to the concession stand immediately after the end of your game.

Pitchers will be given one balk warning per pitcher per inning

Run Rules:

15 after 4 innings 10 after 5 innings

No inning can start after 1 hr. 45 min.

In the event of a tie at the end of regulation play the California Tie Break will be used.

Coaches may choose before game starts to:

- -Bat entire roster (free substitution)
- -Bat nine and use normal substitution with starters being able to re-enter the game once in their original batting order spot.
- -If a team bats the entire roster and there is an injury, the injured player's spot in the batting order will be skipped and no out will be recorded.

Pitcher may not re-enter as a pitcher. Straight baseball rules will be played.

Umpires rulings are final. (No Protests Allowed)
