R#3b - Procedures for a TIED GAME at the END OF THE OPEN INNING

All innings played AFTER OPEN INNING are called EXTRA INNINGS.

Procedures for EXTRA INNINGS

The 1st EXTRA INNING:

HOME PLATE WILL OPEN TO PASS BALLS (BOD: 4/13/25)

The player in the batting order who is listed PRIOR to the player scheduled to bat will start the inning on 2nd BASE.

EVERY EXTRA INNING AFTER THE FIRST ONE will:

HOME PLATE WILL OPEN TO PASS BALLS 1 (BOD: 4/13/25)

The player in the batting order who is listed PRIOR to the player scheduled to bat will start the inning on 3rd BASE.
