### Old Business to review from January Meeting

1. Portable Pitching Mounds (revisited after approving use in 2020)

**DECISION:** to continue to allow portable mounds with clarification that they **MUST** be in use during regular season in order to be used during tournament play

The bigger concern of members was the safety of portable mounds. It was noted that there are a variety of styles and sizes and not all of them are safe to use for games. Many are made for practice situations.

League President agreed to look into portable mounds and come back with potential league minimum specification requirements for the representatives at the April meeting. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT TOWNS HOLD OFF PURCHASING UNTIL AFTER THE April meeting**

2. Website Update

Operating and Field Rules sections of the website are being updated for 2022 which includes the format and a Table of Contents

3. DEFERRED to April Meeting: A review of areas needing improvement and areas of success in 2021

4. Nebraska Legion Rule related to players playing both in Tri-Co League and Legion games:

5. State Legion may need to provide permission to allow a player to play in both organizations during the regular season.

It also requires that pitches be counted in both organizations

It prevents a player from playing in any other organization during tournament games
