## **Coach Review Packet – Pony Division**

I have prepared a packet for review. I have done best I can to provide the information and an outline used at the meeting. Unfortunately, this lacks some of the explanation on certain items and lacks the emphasizes on some of the topics.

As the town representative I am looking for you to help fill in gaps that might arise.

- So, I recommend looking over material and if there questions contact me prior to reviewing with the absent coach.
- **The sign off page MUST be returned to be by 5/10/24**
- Appreciate Your Assistance in getting this completed.

## **OUTLINE {Reference numbers are listed next to topics}**

### **1. Portable Mounds**

- ❖ Explain that portable mounds are permitted in league and tournament play but **MUST** meet the minimum requirements established by the league (see item # 1) and the mound **MUST** be used from the beginning of the season (Can't be used in middle or at the end of season or tournament play). Nothing smaller may be used – No Exceptions
- ❖ If there is ANY violation of this - it needs to be reported to League President before start of game

### **2. Baseballs APPROVED** for league & tournament play (see item # 2 ) Only the balls on this page are approved (new ones may be added – reference link on league home page).

- ❖ It is critical that coaches ensure that **NO OTHER** balls get into the game. As the town representative **MAKE SURE THEY HAVE** plenty of **APPROVED BASEBALLS** for fouls, lost or damaged balls for the duration of all league and tournament games.
- ❖ Any violation needs to be reported to the League President.

### **3. Score books and Game Changer**

Our league rules **REQUIRE THAT** complete names and numbers are documented prior to the start of the game.

**4. Review that the league utilizes ORDER BY NAME LINEUP METHOD (OBN).**

It is the primary format if there are any issues regarding substitutions or batting out of order.

**5. Unannounced Substitutions – This needs to be reviewed with the primary emphasis that there is NO Infraction and there IS NO PENALTY in these cases (In both items review # 3 )**

**6. Review the Batting Out of Order Flow Chart to understand the proper steps if this were to occur. (see item # 4 )**

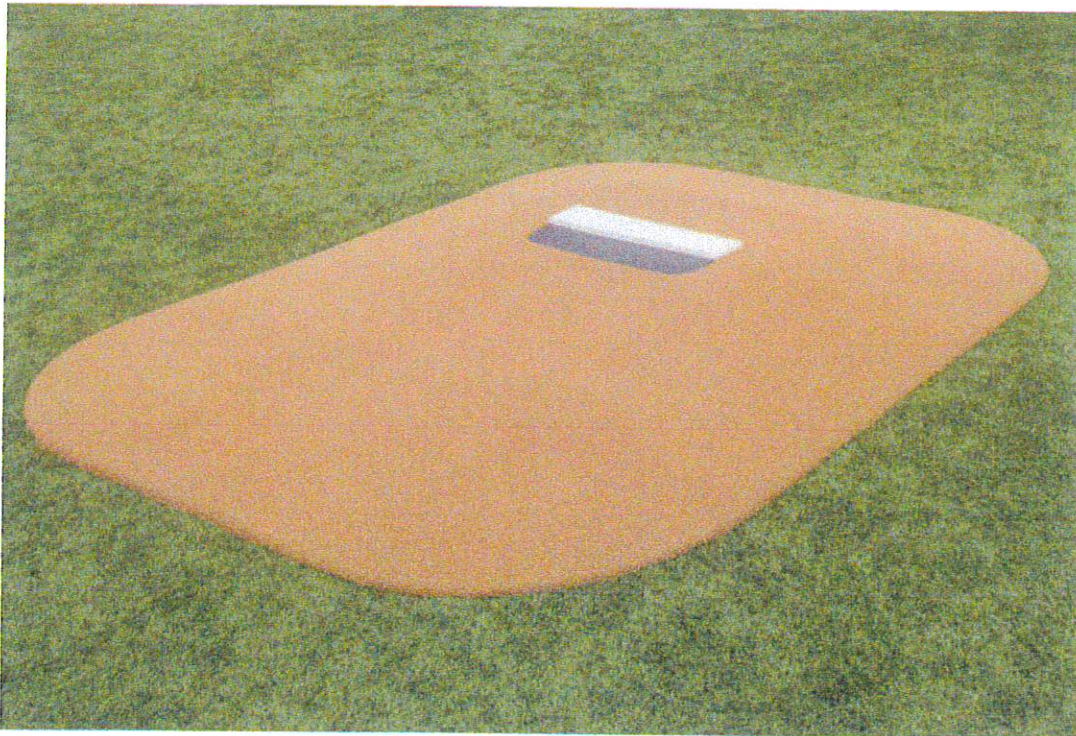

League Approved Minimum Criteria for use of Portable Mound for both League and Tournament Play (ALL DIVISIONS - NO EXCEPTIONS)

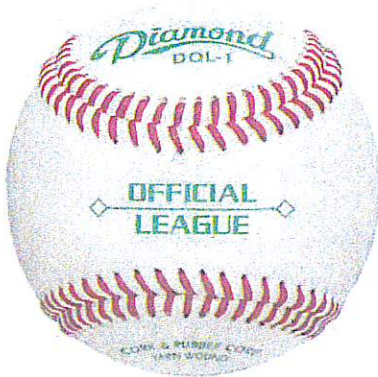
- No portable mounds smaller than these dimensions will be allowed for 2024 season and beyond.
  - Minimum Dimensions: 7' x 9' x 6"
- No mounds smaller than these dimensions will be ALLOWED FOR league or tournament games and mounds previously purchased WILL NOT BE grandfathered in!!



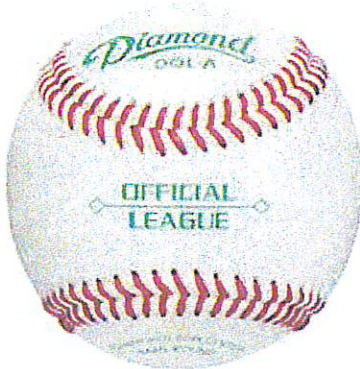
### Baseballs for League and Tournament Games

- ONLY the below style or approved balls can be used for league play. No older balls can be used
- The final listing of balls used by specific towns will be provided to town representatives and coaches
- If Diamond Brand Baseballs are not to be used by specific towns they MUST submit to the League President the brand, style number and picture of the ball for approval by 5/1/24 so the quality of the ball can be verified.

ORDER BY NAME LINEUP METHOD (OBN) is used by the TriCo League for substitution or batting out of order decisions

## UNANNOUNCED SUBSTITUTIONS

If a manager fails to notify the plate umpire of an otherwise legal substitution on the field, what you have is an UNANNOUNCED SUBSTITUTION (5.10(j))

When this happens the substitution takes affect when the player takes his proper position on the field, specifically

The pitcher takes the mound

A batter steps into the batter's box

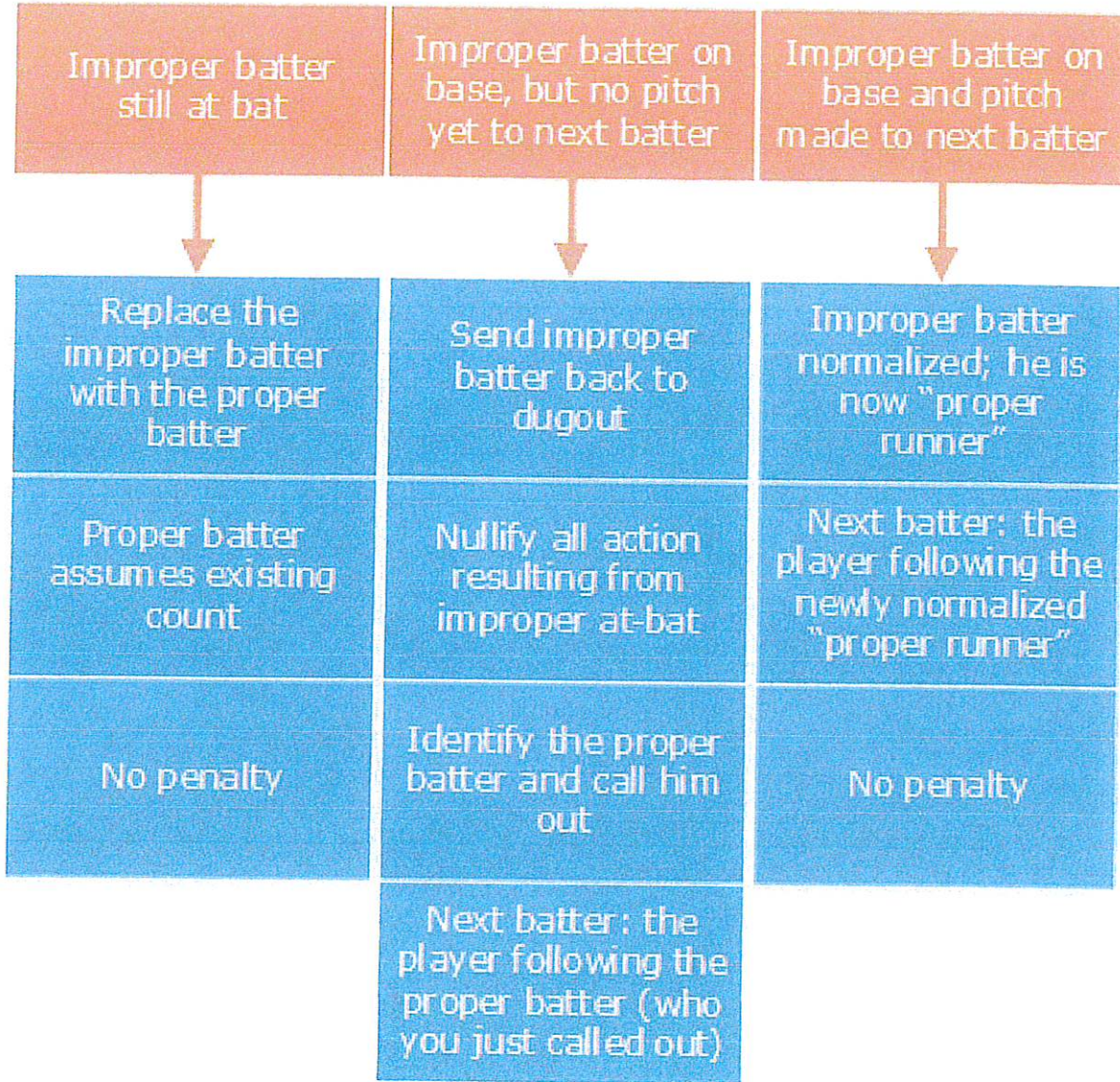
A fielder takes his defensive position and play begins , OR

A runner takes the place of another runner

Ultimately, you treat an unannounced substitution just like any other substitution.

It is NOT AN INFRACTION and THERE IS NO PENALTY (even though some opposing managers will try to tell you there is)

## 2024 Per-Game Checklist

\_\_\_ **Score books or tablets must have players full names and uniform numbers listed**  
**Uniforms:** MUST have numbers on uniforms to participate in the game

\_\_\_ **Declared prior to the start of the game if any of these are used**

Extra Hitter (EH)  
DESIGNATED HITTER (DH)  
ALL PLAYERS IN LINE UP (APL)

\_\_\_ **Reviewed TIME LIMIT / MERCY RULE**

**DIDGET:** Any Inning started after Eighty (80) minutes or (7:20pm) will  
"OPEN INNING" - No Exceptions.

**BRONCO:** Starts when 1st batter gets into batter's box and NO NEW INNING starts  
after 2 Hour Time Limit. The 2 Hour rule SUPERCEDES the Mercy Run Rule

\_\_\_ **PONY:** 15 after 3 - 10 after 4 - 8 after 5

\_\_\_ **Pitches Allowed Between Innings**

Returning pitcher is FIVE (5)  
NEW PITCHERS is EIGHT (8) (New inning or relief)

\_\_\_ **Strike Zone**

**Didgets** - Bottom of chin to top of ankle's.  
**Bronco and Pony** - Armpits to top of knees  
**ALL DIVISIONS** - Outside to outside of plate including black border.

\_\_\_ **Slide Rule**

Runners MUST make an attempt to avoid contact with an opposing player.  
On any plays on 1<sup>st</sup> - 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> bases SLIDING IS NOT REQUIRED.

Catchers / Players MUST allow runners the opportunity to home plate  
THEY CANNOT BLOCK BASE PATH

Catchers / Players may NOT go up the third base line & block the runner from reaching home plate.

If this occurs, then the Catcher / Player will be called for interference and runner will be Called SAFE - awarded home plate and the run.

**Umpire's decisions ARE FINAL**

Sliding is ONLY REQUIRED AT HOME PLATE IF THERE IS PLAY for an out and a player is protecting home plate and the ball is catchable then the runner **MUST** slide.

**Failure to slide will result in the runner being CALL OUT (NO EXCEPTIONS!)**

**Umpire's decisions in these situations ARE FINAL.**

If an umpire feels there was CLEAR INTENT to CAUSE BODILY INJURY BY EXCESSIVE CONTACT THE UMPIRE MAY EJECT THE PLAYER FROM THE GAME.

\_\_\_ **Defensive Substitution** – Must be reported immediately (cannot wait till up to bat). Those Players are then married together for rest of game.

Violation's will result in a "WARNING and incident reported to League President.

**Offensive Substitution** - MUST be reported when player reports to bat.

If a violation occurs then follow League Flow Chart that was provided at coaches meeting.

## Base Running

### Didget Division

No leading off of any base until ball crosses over home plate  
No running on dropped 3rd strikes  
Cannot steal bases when ball is being returned to pitcher  
Home is CLOSED on pass balls & attempted throwbacks to the pitcher (from anywhere on field)

### Bronco Division

8 Foot rule is observed at first base - Player CANNOT touch the 8-foot chalk line.  
(This is measured from side of 1st base facing 2nd base)  
Runner may attempt to steal 2nd base as soon as the pitcher makes any movement toward home plate or to pick off a runner on a base

**1st Offense:** All runners will return to their original base and the pitch is considered a dead ball.  
**2nd Offense:** ANY runner at 1st base that crosses the line a second time during the game, That player will be called OUT and the pitch is considered a dead ball.  
All other runners will return to their original base.  
Players can lead off of any other base without any restrictions.

### Pony Division - Normal baseball rules

#### Balks

Pitchers in both Bronco & Pony divisions will receive one warning per game.  
2nd balk by same pitcher follows normal baseball rules.  
NOTE: Movement by the pitcher to 3rd base then to 1st base is considered a balk

#### Check Base & Mound Distances

<b>BASES:</b>	Didget - 60 feet	Bronco - 70 feet	Pony - 80 feet
<b>MOUND:</b>	Didget - 42 feet	Bronco - 48 feet	Pony - 54 feet

#### Equipment

**Helmets:** MUST have face guards or chin guards.  
**Shoes:** Rubber Cleats or football style cleats (Steel Cleats NOT ALLOWED)  
**Bats:** Max diameter is 2 3/4 inches / Max length is thirty-four (34) inches

## **FR#8 - Batting Line-Up Options**

### **FR#8a - Designated Hitter**

- 1 - Allowed in both the Bronco & Pony Divisions (NOT DIDGET DIVISION).
- 2 - Must be DECLARED PRIOR TO THE START OF THE GAME
- 3 - If the Designated Hitter is used then the Extra Hitter CANNOT be used.

### **FR#8b - Extra Hitter**

#### **BOD APPROVED (4/11/2010) EXTRA HITTER RULE (EH) for ALL DIVISIONS:**

- 1 - Allowed in ALL DIVISIONS
- 2 - Must be DECLARED PRIOR TO THE START OF THE GAME
- 3 - If the Extra Hitter is used then the Designated Hitter CANNOT be used.

#### **EXPLANATION OF EXTRA HITTER RULE:**

Allows for an extra player to be added to the batting order (Didgets > 11)(Bronco-Pony > 10)

The EH Rule allows any of the players listed in the batting order to play in the field without regard to substitution rules.

**Note: if the pitcher is removed from the game, then they CANNOT re-enter to pitch**

The substitution rule will ONLY apply when another player is added to the batting order. Once the EH Rule is DECLARED IT MUST BE USED THROUGHOUT THE GAME.

## **FR#8c - All Players on Lineup Batting**

**BOD APPROVED (3/21/21):** Each town has the authority to allow their teams to use this option.

1 - Allowed in ALL DIVISIONS

2 - Must be DECLARED PRIOR TO THE START OF THE GAME

3 - Once DECLARED IT MUST BE USED THROUGHOUT THE GAME.

4 - Substitution is allowed free will between all the players on the roster

**Note: if the pitcher is removed from the game, then they CANNOT re-enter to pitch**

5 - For ANY REASON, a player cannot bat then it will be handled as an "OUT" – No Exceptions

6 - If a Courtesy Runner is WANTED for the Catcher, then it MUST be the last batter called out

**THE COURTESY RUNNER IN THIS SITUATION IS DIFFERENT THAN OTHER LINEUPS DUE TO EVERY PLAYER IS IN THE BATTING ORDER - EVERY PLAYER IS IN THE GAME/LINEUP.**

## **FR#9 - Regular League Line Up - Batting - Field Rules** **DIDGET (Clarification TO THIS SECTION BY PRESIDENT 5/23/23)**

1 - If a team has ten players in the dugout to start a game, then Ten Players MUST be in the lineup and they Must have Ten defensive players on the Field.

2 - If a team has ten or more players at start of game in the dugout the batting order MUST have ten (10) players.

3 - A Team that has ten (10) or more players able to play and in the dugout and does.

NOT bat ten (10), that team will be issued an OUT

4 - If a team starts a game with ONLY ten (10) players on the lineup and in the dugout.

and an injury reduces the team to nine or less players, the team can bat nine. with NO PENALTY.

5 - If a team starts a game after the 1st pitch with ten players in the dugout and on the lineup and a player becomes sick or ill the MUST be replaced by a substitute

otherwise, if that player is unable to play then an out will be recorded in their position in the batting order

-----  
If A Didget team ONLY has nine players for the game - they can play with nine WITH NO PENALTY OUT

1 - If a team only has nine (9) players TO START a game and has a player join the team after

the game has started, the new player can join the field immediately and is placed at the

bottom of the batting order.

## **FR#2i - Unsportsmanlike Conduct Procedures**

**{BOD: 1/21/24} - Approved Immediate Suspension from league play for duration of season as determined by the League President**

1- We expect excellent sportsmanship to occur during all Tri County League events.  
2 - Sportsmanship includes many parts - attitude, intensity, commitment, and the way we interact with each other.

3 - GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL OF US - ESPECIALLY EXAMPLES SET BY COACHES AND PARENTS.

4 - No coach, player, umpire, or fan shall engage in any grossly unsportsmanlike conduct

**Including, but not limited to:** throwing equipment, profanity, arguing, yelling, or directing remarks to

or at any player, coach, or umpire during or after any Tri County Baseball League events.

5 - UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED IN THE LEAGUE
