Coach Responsibilities Season Starts

Prior and during Regular Season

Access website before season starts to get familiar with the links and sections.

LEAGUE WEBSITE ADDRESS: www.tricoleague.com – **Critical read items below**

- Most important Link on web page is **“2025 LEAGUE INFO”**
In that link are: Field Rules / Umpire Information / Forms / Tournament Information and pending Tournament Schedule.
- Field Rules cover both regular season & tournament play:
- Home Page (left Side) of Website Standings, Schedule, Teams & Coach List.
- In the Town Listings Section, you will find: Field Directions, List of Teams, coach contact information and Standings.
- **SHARE** the website link with both parents and players.
- Need to watch for **NOTIFICATIONS** by text messaging or posted on **HOME PAGE**

After Game Responsibilities

- Hard copy score books (home and visitor if used) **MUST** be signed by a responsible person, delegated person, or coaches.
- If an IPAD is used by the home team to report game information, I **MUST** be informed that an IPAD was used.
If both teams are using IPADs please note that when reporting.
- **IF THERE IS A CONFLICT AND THE BOOKS ARE NOT SIGNED BY BOTH PARTIES THEN THE HOME BOOK / IPAD (Gamechanger) WILL BE CONSIDERED THE OFFICIAL BOOK.**
- If there are repeated issues with reporting, your representative will be contacted.

REPORTING SCORES

- **THE HOST TOWN COACH** is responsible for reporting all required game information **NO LATER THAN** the following day.
Items Required to Report:
- Score of the game
- Pitchers initials, Uniform Numbers for both teams
Example: BS#23 (3), TR#2 (1)
{This is WHY YOU NEED FULL NAMES AND #S IN BOOKS or in IPAD}
- Number of innings pitched by all pitchers in the game for both teams.
DO NOT COUNT 1/3 – 2/3 outs
One pitch is considered full inning
- Games **POSTPONED DUE TO WEATHER / FIELD CONDITIONS**
Note: Rescheduling of ANY POSTPONED game **MUST BE APPROVED BY** League President

(bolded box around teams that are split to see easier)

(split could have some with a home game so check schedule—mostly split are away)

TOURNAMENT

- There will be a Two Tier Tournament like previous years.
- High Seed will be the home team throughout entire tournament.
- In Semi and 3rd / Final games home team will get to select time of game they preferred. HOMER HOST FOR DIDGET UPPER TOURNAMENT
- All teams participate in the tournament.
- No Awards for Blue 'lower tier' per representatives decision in 2024

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Cancellation of games are ONLY APPROVED BY League President.

- Rescheduling games is allowed for SCHOOL EVENTS ONLY WHEN SCHOOL IS IN SESSION.
(FOOTBALL / BASKETBALL during summer ARE NOT CONSIDERED SCHOOL EVENTS)
- ROSTERS CAN BE UPDATED UNTIL 6/23.
- SAFETY and POPUP BASES ARE NOT REQUIRED
- SLIDING HEADFIRST IS ACCEPTABLE (EACH TEAM TO DECIDE FOR THEIR PLAYERS)
- SUNGLASSES FOR PITCHERS NO LONGER ALLOWED
- GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP
- COACH CONTACT INFORMATION TO BE UPDATED BY 5/7
